

South Africa's National Peace Accord structures

National structures

National Peace Committee (NPC)

Representatives of signatory parties. Oversaw implementation, monitored compliance with Code of Conduct for political groups and dispute resolution.

National Peace Secretariat (NPS)

Representatives of 4 major political parties. 1 person from the Peace Directorate & chaired by independent advocate. Charged with establishing and coordinating RPCs.

Commission of Inquiry Regarding the Prevention of Public Violence (Goldstone Commission)

Police Board

Local and regional structures

Regional Peace Committees (RPCs)

1 per province, 11 nationally.

Representatives of political and religious groups, business, unions, local authorities, police and defence forces, LPCs and other stakeholders.

Socio-Economic Reconstruction & Development Committees. 1 per region to broker development projects

Local Peace Committees (LPCs)

Approximately 260 nationally.

Membership reflected composition of community. Accountable to RPC.

Police Reporting Officers.

1 per region

Special Criminal Courts
(created in many localities)

Peace Monitors

Approx. 15,000
